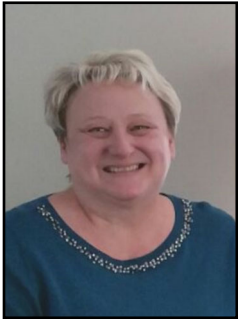


AAA Staff Bios
