
Comprehensive Community Services (CCS) Data Analysis Geographical representation of CCS participants

<u>Goal</u>: Determine if the geographical distribution of CCS participants in Dane County is representative of the eligible population.



Methods: Analysis conducted June 2019, using data for all 2018 CCS participants

<u>Results</u>: 91% of CCS participants in 2018 resided in urban areas of Dane County. The distribution does not significantly differ from an estimated 89% of MA-eligible residents residing in urban areas (χ_1^2 =3.53, p=0.065).

<u>Conclusions</u>: Based on these data, the distribution of CCS participants in urban versus rural regions of Dane County is representative of the distribution of MA-eligible individuals.
