## HOW WE HELP YOU REACH YOUR EMPLOYMENT GOALS

### **01 ASSETS AND BARRIERS IDENTIFICATION**

A VFPS Transition Navigator assists the student's team to create an inventory of vocational strengths and assets. Barriers to employment are identified along with strategies to address them.

VFPS DELIVERS: Assets inventory and work-based learning plan

#### 02 CAREER EXPLORATION AND GOAL VALIDATION

We use school year and summer work based learning experiences to identify and validate job goals. We assess the impact of employment on Social Security and other programs through a Benefits Analysis.

VFPS DELIVERS: Customized resume & plan for employment

#### 03 GUIDED JOB SEARCH

The VFPS Job Development Specialist collaborates with school staff to find jobs that are well suited to the job seeker and cost effective to support.
