Questions and Answers

QUESTION 1:
The service unit figures for the AODA outpatient RFP are listed as 7,308. Does that number reflect only the direct service units for the past year or both the direct service units and case management units?
ANSWER
The 2007 unit of service figure is representative of outpatient services only. As of May 13, 2008, the reported units of service data relevant for this RFP are 7,179 units of service provided in outpatient services and 4,076 units of service provided in case management activities. In 2007, a total of 640 individuals received outpatient counseling and/or case management services.
QUESTION 2
Are we expected to complete the RFP for the total service units only, and then if contracted negotiate the mix of direct and case management? Or are you expecting us to identify the proposed mix of services in the RFP? Or... are we expected to contract only for direct service units (at a higher cost) and then add in case management service units if contracted (which reduces the cost per service unit)
ANSWER
Applicants are asked to identify the proposed mix of case management and outpatient counseling within the application as well as the unit cost for each service.
