## WHAT'S COMING UP?

### **FAFSA News:**

#### **FAFSA season is in full swing!**

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (or FAFSA) is the main hub for all college goers to apply for federal and state grants (free money) as well as public loans (borrowed money).

#### **2024-2025 FAFSA Deadlines:**

The FAFSA form needs to be submitted by 11:59p.m. CT on June 30, 2025

#### **Why This Matters For Kinship Youth**

There are a wide range of financial opportunities available to current kinship care and former foster youth to help pay for college. If a young person was in kinship care or foster care for one day after their 13th birthday and can provide documentation of their care status, they could be eligible to receive thousands of dollars in aid.

This could not only pay for their tuition, but also potentially put some money in their pockets to help ease the burden of balancing work and school responsibilities. Because kinship and foster youth are considered "independent students," they don't have to report any financial information about biological parents, foster parents or guardians. The only financial information they need to include is their own, making them eligible for many grants that they don't have to pay back.

### WORK PERMITS

**A work permit is required before anyone under the age of 16 is allowed to work with the exception of agriculture or domestic service work.**

**Starting July 1st of 2023, our office will no longer be able to create work permits for youth as the permissions will only be granted to the youth's parent/guardian. Work Permits can be created online using the following link:**

### OPERATION FRESH START

*Est 1970*

Operation Fresh Start empowers emerging adults on a path to self-sufficiency through education, mentoring, and employment training.

#### LEGACY Program (Ages 16-24)

Operation Fresh Start Legacy program is a great way to finish high school and take real-world steps toward whatever career calls them. In this personal growth and development program, youth will learn through paid, hands-on employment training on an actual job site – and through one-on-one, independent, and small-group academic work in a classroom setting.

#### BUILD Academy (Ages 18-24)

Build Academy is a full-time, hands-on, paid training program for ages 18–24. They will earn a starting wage of \$15/hour while training for a construction career. Youth will have the opportunity to train alongside industry professionals, gaining skills while also building a professional network. Learn to meet industry standards of craftsmanship and speed, as well as earn credentials that construction employers are looking for. Successful program completion includes placement into a self-sustaining career in the trades.
