Our clinicians have a wide variety of training and specializations including Neurofeedback, TRE, EMDR, and DBT. All of our clinicians work from a trauma-informed and client centered perspective.

We provide a full service dialectical behavior therapy program to individuals as young as 13 years of age. The program includes: weekly skills training group (core mindfulness, interpersonal effectiveness, emotion regulation, and distress tolerance skills), weekly individual therapy, daily diary cards, 24/7 phone coaching and parent/caregiver involvement. This evidence based treatment serves clients who have demonstrated difficulty managing emotions, impulsive behaviors and suicidal thoughts.
